

Resolution on Addressing Food Waste

in the Delegation of Russia

The United Nations Security Council, Recognizing the significant global issue of food waste and its detrimental impact on both the environment and human welfare;

Acknowledging the responsibility of nations to address and mitigate food waste within their borders,
Deeply concerned by the level of food waste within the delegation of Russia which contributes to global food insecurity and environmental degradation,

- . Urges the delegation of Russia to prioritize efforts to reduce food waste at all levels of society, including households, businesses, and government institutions, through measures to minimize overproduction, improve storage facilities, and facilitate food redistribution;
- . Implementing public awareness campaigns to educate citizens about the consequences of food waste and promote responsible consumption habits;
- Encouraging the adoption of sustainable food practices, such as composting, donation to food banks, and the use of innovative technologies to extend the shelf life of food products;
 - Implementing regulations and incentives to reduce food waste in the food production, distribution and retail sectors, including measures to minimize overproduction, improve storage facilities, and facilitate food redistribution;
 - Collaborating with international organizations and other nations to share best practices and develop joint initiatives to combat food waste on a global scale.
- Calls upon the delegation of Russia to report regularly on the progress made in reducing food waste generation, disposal methods, and the effectiveness of implemented measures;

- encourages the international community to provide support and assistance to the delegation of Russia in its efforts to combat food waste, including through technical assistance, capacity building, and financial resources;
- Reminds all member states of their obligation to uphold the principles of sustainable development and environmental stewardship, including the reduction of food waste, as outlined in the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

Decides to remain seized of the matter and requests the delegation of Russia to provide updates on its progress in addressing food waste during subsequent sessions of the United Nations Security Council.
