The general Assembly,

Having in mind the Incheon Declaration of 2015 and its education goals for 2030 as well as the 26th Article of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights

Reminding to all that 258 million children are out of school that is 17% of children in age to go to school that or not attending and insisting on the fact that having a quality education means that education must be available and accessible as well as adaptable to all, moreover quality education means having access to non-formal education

Emphasizing that nearly 771 million young people and adults do not master the necessary literacy skills to be able to think and act comfortably in today's society

Lamenting on the access to education during the Covid-19 pandemic as nearly 91% of students worldwide were impacted by school closures and lacked quality facilities to continue normal education

Knowing that this pandemic has further widened the inequalities between children around the world to have access to a complete and fulfilling education

Knowing that access to quality infrastructure is limited for some countries, especially in Sub-Saharan Africa

Thanking the members of the general assembly

1. Asks that new schools capable of welcoming everyone and able to support new devices for the benefit of quality education be built as well as other buildings dedicated to non-formal education such as sport or arts,

- 2. Encourages the establishments of financial aids to help the physical access to school to student who lives far from their education places
- 3. Asks that the number of scholarships to help follow higher education for developing countries be increased, and recalls that it would take nearly 200 billion euros more to be able to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 4 of 2030
- 4. Calls for an even more important point to be made about the environmental circumstances during the future's education programs to prevent an aggravation of the ongoing climate change by having adult aware of the importance of the well being of the earth
- 5. Reaffirms that education is given by professors and so demand they're provided with a good work environment so that they can teach in the best way possible
- 6. Invite to create a digital platform accessible to all were student can have access to an education if their school is momentarily closed so as not to reproduce the events during the COVID-19 pandemic were a third of the student around the world hadn't access to digital education
