Question: Al and education - Ensure equal access to fair Al tools for all?

The General Assembly,

Emphasizing that the international community must demand equal access to unbiased and fair AI (Artificial Intelligence) tools for all,

Mindful of the previous resolutions taken in the Beijing Consensus on Artificial Intelligence and Education of May 2019,

Deploring the unbalanced access to Al tools in schools used in the educational process, among which, disparities between public and private establishments looking to implement Al as a pedagogical tool,

Highly aware of the lack of diversity in data pools, leading to teaching bias that are detrimental to students with learning disabilities or who come from a minority group,

Stressing the importance of showcasing cultural diversity and presenting diversified regional norms to students,

- 1) Considers that Al tools be made more accessible by making sure that nations offer monetary aids to schools who wish to develop them,
 - a. to ensure that schools be provided with the necessary funds needed to set up AI programs,
 - b. to insist on the training of teachers and pedagogical assistants;
- 2) Demands that the data provided in the development of AI tools be expanded in order to offer an equal experience for all students to create an inclusive learning atmosphere,
 - a. to adapt to disabilities students may have;
- 3) Declares that AI should not push a biased vision of the world and be adapted to different cultural backgrounds to prevent their erasure,
 - a. to be adapted to national heritage and prevent the globalization of cultural norms;
- 4) Insists that innovative breakthroughs should be shared amongst members of the United Nations a. to offer equal tools to schools,
 - b. to ensure a fair chance at education for all.
