QUESTION: AI: a resource for education?

**Recalling** the principles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, in particular the right of everyone to enjoy the benefits of scientific progress.

**Recognizing** that Artificial Intelligence (AI) is an essential technology for solving global challenges and improving the lives of all, as cited in UNDP Resolution 4418 {2024}.

*Emphasizing* that many people, especially in poor or isolated regions, do not have access to these tools, which increases inequalities.

*Stressing* the importance of acting quickly to ensure that AI benefits everyone without discrimination.

- 1. *Commits* to ensuring that everyone, without distinction, has equal access to AI tools and can use them to improve their living conditions.
- 2. *Accepts* that States must invest in technological infrastructures, such as Internet access so that isolated or disadvantaged populations are connected by setting a mandatory minimum budget.
- 3. *Calls* for a reduction in the gap between rich and poor regions in terms of access to these technologies, by contributing aid to the most disadvantaged regions.
- 4. *Urges* countries to set up training courses to learn how to use AI as early as secondary school, so that every individual has the basic skills to use AI.
- 5. *Offers* specific programs to include people who are often excluded, such as women, minorities or people with disabilities. (In some regions)
- 6. *Calls* on states to establish laws to ensure that AI respects human rights, such as privacy or non-discrimination.

- 7. *Declares* to companies developing AI to make their systems transparent and understandable to all, adapted to people with disabilities, including the blind or visually impaired.
- 8. *Proposes* the creation of a global fund to help countries that do not have the means to equip themselves with these tools, so that everyone has equitable access to these resources.
- 9. *Appeals* to the most advanced countries to share their technologies and know-how with others, in order to advance humanity.
- 10. *Ensures* that the United Nations monitors countries' progress in accessing and using AI on an annual basis.
- 11. **Declares** a monthly report published to identify obstacles and best practices in AI with the participation of all member countries.
