QUESTION : Ensuring quality education for all

SUBMITTED BY : United Kingdom

The General Assembly,

*Reaffirming* that the right to education is a fundamental right ratified by mankind within the United Nations in 1945 in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights,

*Considering* that “since wars begin in the minds of men, it is in the minds of men that the defenses of peace must be constructed”, UNESCO organization has the responsibility and duty to provide and promote education for all throughout the world,

*Recalling also* the 1990 world conference on education for all which sets goals for each ratifying country to achieve with the idea of creating a population with the tools of knowledge,

*Deploring* that around 258 millions children and young people worldwide are deprived of education for reasons related to social, economic and cultural factors,

*Seriously concerned* by recent Unesco statistics from 2022 showing that 771 millions young people and adults lack basic literacy skills,

1.*Stresses* the need to find active solutions after the coronavirus health crisis which has greatly slowed down the educational process of students by raising fund and investing in the creation of new schools in the developing countries

2.*Commits* itself to the education of women in developing countries through the creation of an international student exchange programme with these countries in the hope to encourage international relationship

3.*Calls* for the systematic equality of women and men necessary for the development of our society in the field of education

4.*Demand* the association of UN Women and WHO in an open letter for the development of Women education and security

Open Letter address to the general assembly :

Association of WHO (World Health Organization), UNESCO (United Nations for Educational,  
Scientific and Cultural Organization ) and UN Woman.

We believe that Women can make a real difference to insure a sustainable and global development, we believe in the equality of chances, we believe in a free patriarchal society, we believe in progress, we believe that this can become a reality if we join our resources and forces. This is why we call for a special association of the United Nations institutions.

We call the nations to join our program: together we can change things

UN WOMEN:

- Sponsor of the association: ensures in the coordination of the operations conducted
- Financing: massive fundraising from rich countries plus collection of donations from all nations = citizen initiative
- Development cannot be done without women = development factor
- A strategy put in place by two pillars of action: ensuring the safety of women through WHO and ensuring their education through UNESCO

WHO :

- creation of clinics specialized in the reception of women in developing countries: information center on contraception/sexually transmitted diseases, protection against conjugal violence and help/accompaniment= psychological cell, liberation of the word
- opening vaginal reconstruction clinics to help women who have suffered from excision= 200 million women suffer from excision resulting in medical complications ranging from infections to the death of many women during childbirth.
- creation of maternity wards so that women can benefit from a safe delivery in the best possible conditions of hygiene and psychological support

UNESCO:

- Opening of adult women's schools= to ensure the education of mothers to enable transmission to their children. Sexual education, learning of writing and algebra= to reduce the rate of illiteracy and illiteracy
- Impose on science universities a quota of 35/ by 2030 and 50/ by 2040 = parity in science education
- Exchange program for university student volunteers as teachers for one year = bring teachers to disadvantaged rural areas
