QUESTION : Responsabilité à protéger les minorités.

SOU MIS PAR: La République de Norvège

The General Assembly,

Thanking associations and members from these minorities speaking in their names, without whom these study wouldn't have been possible,

Norway security council, *deploring* the low representation of these minorities within the political system as well as the minorities left behind in northern Norway,

Conscious of the increasing immigration (climatic, economic, war refugees...) across the whole world, fixed by UNO at 265 millions in 2015 versus 188.8 millions in 2000,

Knowing that the number of immigrants is now growing faster than the world population,

Offering a budget of 1.5 billion NOK coming from the Norwegian state,

Worried to integrate, in the best way, minorities originating in our vast country,

Keeping in mind revendications from growing extremist nationalist groups,

Observing the main function of the Security Council, articulated in two key ideas:

- The responsibility of maintaining peace, aiming differences acceptance for the purpose of national and lasting peace
- International Security, aiming welcoming safely foreign immigrants

Deploring a lack of care and safety given to minorities:

1. Claiming a common charter to the countries members of UNO, assuring collectively the minorities security,
2. Suggesting la the creation of a specialized police department, specialized in national minorities aggressions including :
 - a. A criminal research department
 - b. A judicial prosecutor's office
 - c. An association defending rights of integration
3. Encouraging les Police forces to intervene in cases of extremist and racist groups demonstrations :
 - a. Authorize use of batons and tear gas la l'usage de gaz lacrymogènes et de matraques
 - b. Authorize Police to use force in order to dam up racial hatred
4. Proposing a budget of one billion NOK in addition to the one already developed for minorities living in cities,
5. Instigate withdrawal of Norway from Arctic council agreements :
 - a. In the name of Sami community way of life safety
 - b. In the name of environmental defense
 - c. Demand the representation of at least one Sami member in the politics applied in their lands,
6. Demand new places in nurseries and social housing for the "new Norwegians" in order to warranty a job security to the jobless coming from those minorities,
7. Promoting a financial help during a limited period of time to help with professional integration stopped whenever a declared job is found, in order to fight immigrants precarity,
8. Calls for creating new integration help centers :
 - a. Creating additional national language classes
 - b. New jobs of State officials
 - c. Promoting integration and social cohesion
 - d. Offering new reception centers,
9. Hurry each delegation to remain seized of the matter.
