Arizona Senate votes to repeal Civil War-era near-total abortion ban

On Wednesday, May 1st, Arizona's Senate voted to change a one hundred and sixty year old law, banning abortion almost entirely unless the mother's life is in danger and threatens abortion providers with two to five year prison sentences. This bill will now be given to Governor Katie Hobbs who said that she looks forward "to quickly signing the repeal into law". Once signed, the law would go into effect 90 days after the legislature adjourns and will allow abortion until 15 weeks in Arizona.
