Astronomers make rare exoplanet discovery, and a giant leap in detecting Earth-like bodies.

Astronomers have made the rare discovery of a small, cold exoplanet and its massive outer companion -- shedding light on the formation of planets like Earth.

The findings include a planet with radius and mass between that of the Earth and Neptune, with a potential orbit around its host star of 146 days. The star system also contains an outer, large companion, 100 times the mass of Jupiter.

It was detected using the SOPHIE -- a highprecision pectrograph (a machine that analyses wavelengths of light from exoplanets) at the Haute-Provence Observatory, France

Mr Lai, member of the Democratic Progressive Party, was elected as president of Taiwan by its voters, taking over his predecessor Tsai Ing-wen. As China's claims over the island become more and more oppressive, this election brougth both deligth reassurance regarding Taiwan's independence, but also fear over the reaction of China, especially from supporters of the opposite party, Kuomintang: Xi Jinping has already banned Mr Lai from traveling to mainland China, and holds power over the economy and security of the island. As communication and dialogue seem nearly impossible, Mr Lai is walking on eggshells to maintain secure international relationships not only with Beijing, but also with his allies such as the United States and Japan which could offer military help if needed.
