These events began in November 2022 when Eva Kaili, former Vice-President of the European Parliament, praised Qatar in her speech on November 22nd, stating, "Qatar is a leader in labor laws." On December 19th, 2022, Eva Kaili's father was arrested in possession of a bag containing 150 000 euros offered by Qatar. She was arrested at her home where several other bags were discovered. The investigation led to the arrest of three other members of parliament, including Francesco Giorgio, the leader of the Italian communist party.

This investigation encountered a new momentum in December 2023 when hundreds of documents were disclosed from the judicial inquiry, highlighting the active lobbying of Qatar, Morocco, and Mauritania in attempting to influence certain decision-making processes.
