October 31, 2022 *The Aviationist* **First Production AW609 Tiltrotor Takes Flight**

A week ago, a new type of civil aircraft, was tested in the USA. Actually, this sort of aircraft is only used in the army : like the well known V22 Osprey in the American forces. Its specificity is that it has two tilting rotors: it can exploit the advantages of both, helicopters and fixed wing aircraft. The AW609 is produced by Leonardo, an Italian company specialised in several domains like aerospace, defence and security sectors. To go further, there may be in the future versions adapted for civil security. It has many mission capabilities that can be used in several domains.
