Unprecedented wildfires in Canada have ravaged millions of hectares, displaced over 100,000 residents, and triggered a national crisis. Firefighters from around the world have joined the exhausted crews in battling the recordbreaking fires. Climate change and human activities are expected to exacerbate future fire seasons. The number of active fires has decreased to 421, with 230 still out of control. The total area burned this year has reached 43,000 sq km, making 2023 the second-worst year on record.
