Oct. 25st *University of Technology, Sydney* **Vision via sound for the blind**



Researchers from the University of Technology Sydney with support from ARIA Research, have created smart glasses using acoustic touch technology. These glasses translate visual information into unique sound representations as they come into view. For example, the sound of rustling leaves might signify a plant, while a buzzing sound might represent a mobile phone. In a study involving 14 participants, the glasses significantly improved the ability of blind or low-vision individuals to recognize and reach for objects, offering a wearable solution for sensory augmentation.

This innovation addresses everyday challenges for the visually impaired and enhances their independence and quality of life, with the potential to become a key assistive technology.
