



# Mimas' surprise: Tiny moon of Saturn holds young ocean beneath icy shell

Saturn's moon Mimas, previously thought barren, astounds scientists with a young global ocean discovered beneath its icy surface. This 5-15 million-year-old ocean, revealed by Cassini spacecraft data, sparks interest in early ocean formation and potential for life beyond Earth. Mimas joins Enceladus and Europa in harbouring vital conditions for life, intensifying the search for extraterrestrial habitats.
